What's Happening Now at the Town Clerk's Office:

The Town of Milford's Annual Election is Tuesday April 7th. Polls will be open from 7:00am until 8:00 pm. **Early Voting is not available for the Annual Town Election.**

If you will be unable to make it to your polling location on Election Day between 7:00 am and 8:00 pm please apply for an **Absentee Ballot** using the following link **as soon as possible to allow sufficient time for the mailing process:**

You can apply for an Absentee Ballot if you are unable to go to your polling locations because:

1. you will be absent from your city or town on Election Day
2. you have a physical disability that prevents you from voting at the polling place
3. you cannot vote at the polls due to religious beliefs
4. you are confined in a correctional facility or jail on something OTHER than a felony charge

You can also apply for an absentee ballot for a family member if they will be unable to vote at their Polling Location on April 7th.

If you are a Service member, an eligible Service family member and/or an overseas citizen you can use the Federal Post Card Application to both register to vote and request an absentee ballot. Use this link for FPCA information: <https://www.fvap.gov/military-voter/overview>

March 18th by 8:00 pm in the Town Clerk's Office, for the April 7th Town of Milford Annual Election

August 12th by 8:00 pm in the Town Clerk's Office, for the September 1st State Primary

October 14th by 8:00 pm in the Town Clerk's Office, for the November 3rd Presidential Election
